What is NDHA?

The North Dakota Hospital Association (NDHA) is a nonprofit membership organization, affiliated with the American Hospital Association, which provides leadership on healthcare issues. The Association provides a forum for the exchange of ideas, information research and methods of improving healthcare delivery. Working with its members and other organizations, the NDHA builds coalitions of interested individuals and organizations to address state healthcare delivery concerns, and develops and promotes effective solutions at national, state, and local levels. The NDHA membership is a diverse collection of organizations and individuals who share a common interest in improving the delivery of healthcare services to advance the health status of North Dakotans.

Why become an Associate Member?

Associate Membership Dues

\$1,000 annually - Dues are prorated for the portion of the fiscal year (October – September) remaining at the time of payment.
